

TheLloyd4U includes more than a dozen improvement projects along the Lloyd Expressway, from Posey County Line Road to Cross Pointe Boulevard. Some permanent road closures are being considered to address safety concerns. A short questionnaire was shared to gather public feedback. The Project Team is also evaluating crash data and traffic count information to assist in the decision-making process.



POTENTIAL CLOSURE LOCATIONS


- S. Ingle Avenue at Lloyd
